

I use the Sioux Chief Ox Box both for our washing machine and icemaker applications for our multifamily housing projects. In relation to real world framing construction installation practices, Ox Box has given us options not offered before seen in a washing machine box. Being able to locate the drain and valve boxes separately on either side of a stud frame without modifying existing framing is not only unique in itself, but also offers installation options which can be installed with very little effort.

In addition, the valve box can be installed with the water connections 'upside down', that is to say with the water supply coming from overhead rather than from the slab. Your box is the first (that I am aware of) to offer this option without field modifications to the box and having to deal with the remaining holes once the valves are relocated.

I could continue with several other points and examples where in my opinion the Ox Box has clear advantages over other manufacturers – but I am certain you are well aware of what they are.

Thanks for developing such a great and much needed product to the plumbing industry.
