I would like to give a testimonial on the importance of keeping the "Universal Slider Bracket - Power Bar" stocked on a service or new construction vehicle. I ran into a situation recently where a customer called me complaining of a water supply line vibrating in the wall at the water closet. In my experience I have found improperly supported piping systems in the walls, and when the adjoining wall was opened, this is exactly what I encountered. I did not have many options to brace the piping without further opening the wall. In order to rectify the situation I cut an 8x8 inch hole in the wall and spanned the 16-inch on center studs with the power bar, solving the problem. I did not have to use any additional means to correct the problem. This saved the customer and me time and money.
