My company recently switched to Sioux Chief Ox Box washer drain and icemaker boxes, and I would like to make the following observations. First, the product is more versatile than any other boxes which we have used. It has eliminated piping conflicts through its two-piece design. No longer is it necessary to adjust piping to conform to the washer drain box. Now the box adapts to our plumbing! This saves time for installation, but also helps to preserve the structural integrity of the wall in which it is installed. We no longer need to squeeze water supply lines past drains in 3 1/2" deep walls, stressing studs and piping; and we don't worry about unsightly charring or melting of the drain pipe any longer. The rigidity of the box, along with optional fastening ability has improved the aesthetic value in the finished wall as well. The Ox Box really stands out from other products with the integrated air chamber. As washing machines and ice makers utilize quick-closing supply valves, we always install air chambers. Not having to spend time on fabrication of this component is a definite benefit. Overall, the Ox Box has alleviated design and installation frustrations that were present for many years. In my opinion, it is a great product.
